

Before the PTA official's testimony, my wife's attorney presented the following fraudulent "Offer of Proof", to the magistrate to get her to allow the testimony:

10 The offer of proof on Miss would be that
11 she's known both of the parties for some number of years,
12 but in the spring of 2004 (sic) went back to
13 Minnesota for the death of her mother and during that time
14 she would see Mr. up at the school picking up the
15 children, that he complained to her that there was no food
16 in the house but cereal and that he and the children had
17 been eating cereal for days,

1 Then she said a couple of days later she
2 noticed that the daughter, , was just filthy and stank,
3 that she hadn't received a bath for the whole spring break
4 week that Miss (sic) had been gone. And so she had
5 come over one day to play with her daughter and they
6 played hairdresser and cleanup so wouldn't think that
7 somebody else was interfering to make sure she got a bath.
8 But Miss was so concerned about 's filthiness that
9 she thought it would be the best way to do it without
10 creating a scene of you're not getting cleaned up by your
11 father so she just played hairdresser and did cleanup day
12 with that day.

13 And that's what Miss 's testimony, as I
14 understand it, would be, Your Honor.

(The attorney's Offer of Proof so closely matched the PTA Official's false testimony that it's hard to tell who made it up. Regardless, both the attorney, who knew me through our church to be a good father, and the official, who knew me fairly well as a loving father, committed this fraud together. The magistrate granted the testimony and my wife's "friend", who was with the PTA and the Girl Scouts and worked at the school at the time, went ahead with their rehearsed fraud on the court.
