2 THE COURT: If you'll raise your right hand.

3 Do you solemnly swear under the pains and

20 A I work for Jefferson County Schools [redacted]

22 Q And what do you do for them?

23 A I'm the principal at he school.

2 Q Could you describe a little bit what -- about
3 how you know Carol?

4 A I know Carol because -- let's see, how many
5 of her children -- three of her five children have attended
6 [redacted] since I've been there.

11 Q All right. And what did Carol do at the
12 school?

13 A She was at parent conferences. She would be
14 at field trips, help out in the classroom, picked them up
15 every day.

16 Q All right. And when did you come to know
17 John [redacted]?

18 A My first recollection of Mr. [redacted] was this
19 past March.

20 Q This past March of '05?

21 A Uh-huh.

(She knew me for several years before this and we saw each other many times before Mar. '05.)

20 Q Okay. Did he indicate to you at that time
21 that he had been excluded from the home?

22 A No, 'cause he was still living on the
23 property.

24 Q He was at that time?

25 A Uh-huh.

(She seemed to know all about the "911 Scam" and was very quick to answer here.)

1 Q Okay. And prior to March of '05, you had had
2 no contact with Mr. [REDACTED] at the school or involvement
3 with the children?

4 A No, not that -- not that I remember. I don't
5 remember him being at a conference. I don't remember
6 meeting him. In fact, I found it kind of interesting, when
7 I introduced myself on the playground, that was the first
8 time he met me.

22 CROSS-EXAMINATION

23 BY MS. :

24 Q Ms. [REDACTED], do you routinely attend each
25 student's parent-teacher conference?

1 A I don't attend every parent-teacher
2 conference, no.

3 Q Have you ever attended a parent-teacher
4 conference of any one of the [REDACTED] children?

5 A No.

(Between 2000 and 2004, I attended most of the parent/teacher conferences for my children until my wife started setting up her divorce and then she wanted that role back -- same with our 4 boy's extra-curricular activities, soccer games, church events, and other public events. This principal saw me over 50 times at plays in the gymnasium, arriving for P/T conferences and after school in the pick-up lane where she almost always was after school when I came to pick up the kids. Her hatred of me at this time was very noticeable. Her perjuries influenced a judicial proceeding and she is, therefore, guilty of at least 2 very serious crimes. She should resign.)
